TRAINING

Graduation from an accredited college of physical therapy.

LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE

- Possession of a current valid license as a Physical Therapist issued by the Physical Therapy Board of California.
- Proof of adequate vehicle insurance and medical clearance may also be required.
- May need to possess a valid driver's license as required by the position.
