

About the Position

Under direction, an employee in this classification performs responsible supervisory and administrative support work directing professional, paraprofessional and clerical staff assigned to one or more work units in a dependent children's residential care facility. They will also oversee and provide court ordered supervision, care, and evaluation of troubled, abused and/or neglected youth residents while providing administrative support to management.

BENEFITS

The County offers an excellent benefits plan which includes a county contribution to health insurance, dental and vision insurance plans. Other benefits also offered by the County include:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

One year as a Shelter Counselor II in San Joaquin County.

OR

Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university and three (3) years performing children's social services work in a shelter, group home or similar setting; or social service case management for children and families.

Substitution: Additional qualifying children's social service experience may substitute for the education on a year-for-year basis to a maximum of two years.

AND

License: Possession of a valid California driver's license if required by the nature of the position.

Special Requirements: Must pass fingerprinting as required by state law. Must obtain CPR and First Aid within six months.

About the Department

The Mary Graham Children's Shelter is an Emergency Temporary Facility for children age newborn up to eighteen years of age who are removed from their homes through no fault of their own. On an annual basis, Mary Graham provides care and support services to about 1000 children. The Shelter provides a variety of support services through a variety of collaborative partners to try and help each child have their individual needs addressed. These support services can include medical/dental services, educational support, behavioral support, and transitional support for children under eighteen years old.
